Subject:- Regarding strict compliance of Haryana Civil Services (Govt. Employees' Conduct) Rules, 2016.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention towards rule 18(2) of the Haryana Civil Services (Govt. Employees' Conduct) Rules, 2016 which is as under:

"Every Govt. employee after his marriage shall furnish a declaration to his Head of Department that he has not taken any dowry. The declaration shall be signed by his wife, father and father-in-law."

2. It has come to the notice of the Govt. that above said provision of the rule is not being complied with, in letter and spirit. The matter has further been examined and it has been decided that a person while entering the Govt. job should give an undertaking in writing that if and when he enters any marital alliance, he shall strictly comply with anti dowry law in letter and spirit and also furnish full details of all the articles of property and amounts of money received by him from his in-laws in any name or manner, whatsoever.

These instructions may be brought to the notice to all concerned, for strict compliance.
