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General Review

माध्यमिक शिक्षा विभाग, की वर्ष 2015–2016 की वार्षिक प्रशासनिक रिपोर्ट की समीक्षा।

01 नवम्बर, 1966 को हरियाणा राज्य के अस्तित्व में आने के पश्चात् शिक्षा का तेजी से गुणात्मक एवं परिमाणात्मक विस्तार हुआ है। राज्य ने शैक्षणिक सुविधाओं के विस्तार में विशेषतः ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में उल्लेखनीय प्रगति की है। शिक्षा का सार्वभौमिकीकरण तथा विभिन्न स्तरों पर शिक्षा की गुणवत्ता में सुधार करना, रिपोर्टाधीन अवधि के दौरान विभाग की गतिविधियों की प्राथमिकता वाले क्षेत्र थे। विद्यार्थियों के सीखने का स्तर अपेक्षित स्तर का नहीं था जिसके लिए सतत प्रयास मास अक्टूबर 2014 से किए जा रहे हैं। अतः बड़े पैमाने पर विद्यालयों का निरीक्षण किया जा रहा है जिसका दीर्घावधि में परिणाम निकलेगा।

2. वर्ष 2015–16 में माध्यमिक शिक्षा पर कुल ₹ 2633.19 करोड़ खर्च किए गए। रिपोर्टाधीन अवधि में राज्य में शिक्षा प्रदान करने के लिए 3363 (1387 सरकारी + 1976 गैर-सरकारी) उच्च विद्यालय तथा 4300 (1871 सरकारी + 2429 गैर-सरकारी) वरिष्ठ माध्यमिक विद्यालय अस्तित्व में थे। कुल 44,656 अध्यापक राज्य में विभिन्न प्रकार के राजकीय उच्च/वरिष्ठ माध्यमिक विद्यालयों में पढ़ा रहे थे। राज्य में उच्च स्तर पर 8.79 लाख तथा वरिष्ठ माध्यमिक स्तर पर 5.96 लाख विद्यार्थी सभी (सरकारी व गैर-सरकारी) विद्यालयों में दाखिल किए गए।

3. अनुसूचित जातियों तथा समाज के अन्य कमजोर वर्गों के बच्चों, विशेषकर छात्राओं को निःशुल्क वर्दी, लेखन-सामग्री, पाठ्य-पुस्तकें, वृत्तिका तथा छात्रवृत्तियों जैसे प्रोत्साहन दिए गए। बालिका शिक्षा पर बल देने के लिए उनको विशेष प्रोत्साहन दिए गए। रिपोर्टाधीन अवधि के दौरान राज्य में पढ़ने वाले समाज के आरक्षित एवं अन्य कमजोर वर्गों के विद्यार्थियों के लिए प्रोत्साहन/वित्तीय सहायता हेतु ₹ 157.37 करोड़ खर्च किए गए।

4. राज्य सरकार ने राज्य में बालिकाओं की शिक्षा में सुधार लाने तथा राष्ट्रीय साक्षरता मिशन को सफल बनाने के लिए साक्षरता परियोजनाओं को गति दी है।

5. दिनांक 01.04.2014 से 31.03.2016 की अवधि के दौरान श्री रामबिलास शर्मा, शिक्षा मन्त्री रहे।

6. श्री टी0सी0 गुप्ता, आई0ए0एस0, प्रधान सचिव, हरियाणा सरकार, शिक्षा विभाग में 01.04.2015 से 11.10.2015 तक कार्यरत रहे। इसके उपरान्त श्रीमती केशनी आनन्द अरोड़ा, आई0ए0एस0 अतिरिक्त मुख्य सचिव, हरियाणा सरकार, विद्यालय शिक्षा विभाग में 31.03.2016 तक कार्यरत रहीं।

7. 01.04.2015 से 31.03.2016 की अवधि के दौरान श्री एम0 एल0 कौशिक, आई0ए0एस0 ने निदेशक माध्यमिक शिक्षा के पद पर कार्य किया।

Review of the Annual Administrative Report of the Secondary Education Department, for the Year 2015-2016

The 29th June, 2017

Ever since the inception of State of Haryana on 1st November 1966, there has been rapid expansion in the field of education, both in terms of quality and quantity. The State has made a remarkable progress in the extension of educational facilities, especially in rural areas. Universalization of education and qualitative improvement in education at different levels were the priority areas of the Department during the period under report. However, the learning level outcome of students was not witnessed upto the desired level for which strenuous efforts were made after October, 2014. Rigorous inspection of schools has been undertaken at all the levels which will yield results in long run.

2. During 2015-2016, a total amount of ₹ 2633.19 crore was spent on Secondary Education. 3363 (1387 Government + 1970 Non Government) High Schools and 4300 (1871 Government + 2429 Non Government) Senior Secondary Schools were functioning in the State during the year under report, for dissemination of education. A total of 44,656 teachers were teaching in various Government High/Senior Secondary Schools and 8.79 lac students at High level, 5.96 lac students at all (Government & Non Government) Senior Secondary level were enrolled in the State.

3. Various incentives like free uniform, stationery, text books, stipends and scholarships were provided to the students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Weaker Sections of the society. Special emphasis was laid on providing greater incentives to girl students. During the period under report, an amount of ₹ 157.37 crore was spent on these incentives/financial aid to students of reserved categories and other weaker sections of society studying in the State.

4. The Department has also geared up Literacy projects to improve girl education and to make the National Literacy Mission a success in the State.

5. During the period from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016, Sh. Ram Bilas Sharma was the Education Minister.

6. Sh. T.C. Gupta, IAS held the office of Principal Secretary, Government of Haryana, School Education from 01.04.2015 to 11.10.2015. Thereafter Smt. Keshni Anand Arora, IAS, remained on the post of Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, School Education Department upto 31.03.2016.

7. Sh. M.L. Kaushik, IAS, from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016 hold the post of Director Secondary Education.
